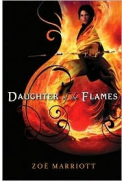


Are you opinionated? Do you like to read? If so, join the BBYA group.

Daughter of the Flames



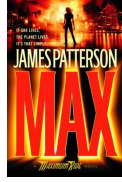
