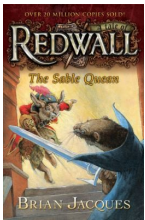

BABYSITTING CERTIFICATION COURSE

The Haverhill Public Library in conjunction with Beverly Hospital will be offering a babysitting certification course on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 from 9:30 am to 4 pm. A trainer from Beverly Hospital's Child Development Center will be teaching the fundamentals of babysitting- including the characteristics of children, how to select toys and games for children's ages, accident prevention, emergency actions, and basic care. Participants will receive a certification of completion from Beverly Hospital. The program is open to Haverhill residents ages 11 - 18. There is a non-refundable \$35 course fee that must be paid at the time of registration. Registration must be completed in person at the Reference/Information desk and will begin on April 1st. Non-Haverhill residents may register beginning April 12th if there are any spaces remaining. Participants will need to bring their own lunch.

Kathryn Lasky– *Ashes*

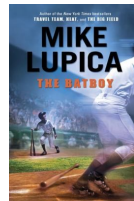

book bury his books and papers in their small yard.

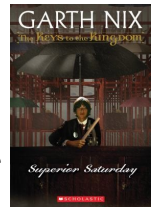
Mike Lupica– *The Batboy*

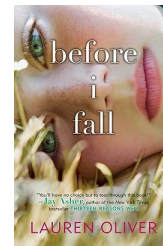


Garth Nix– *Lord Sunday*

Lauren Oliver– *Before I Fall*

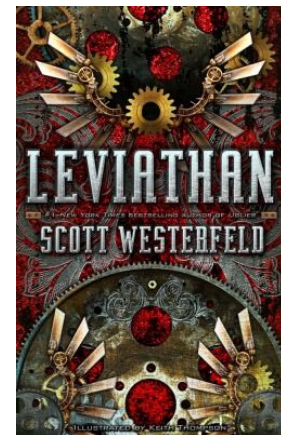


After she dies in a car crash, Samantha relives the day of her death over and over again until, on the seventh day, she finally discovers a way to save herself.
