## HAVE YOU SEEN THE NEW CHAIRS?

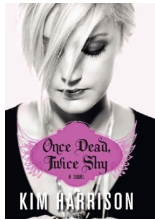

**Kim Harrison—**



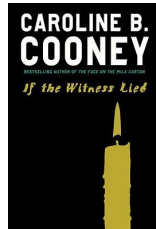
***Once Dead, Twice Shy***

When three boys suspect that their English teacher is responsible for their friend's disappearance, they must navigate a maze of assorted clues before learning the truth.

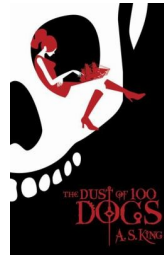
**Caroline B. Cooney—*If the Witness Lied***

**Tim Wynne-Jones— *The Uninvited***

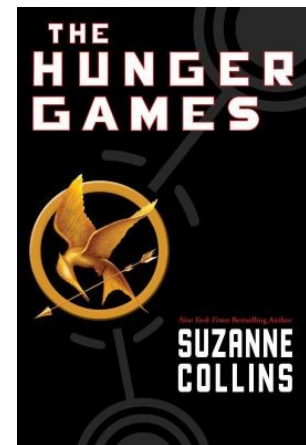
