<b>Abstract:</b>	This collection contains essays written by John G. Moulton, who served as the Librarian of the Haverhill Public Library in Haverhill, Massachusetts, for 21 years.

### Biographical Sketch

John Grant Moulton was born on 26 January 1869, in West Roxbury, Massachusetts, to John H. Moulton (1843-1914) and Frances M. Weld. He graduated from Harvard College and then the Albany School for Librarians. During World War I, he volunteered for library service and was sent first to Camp Jackson, South Carolina, and then overseas. He worked at the Quincy, Illinois, public library from 1894 to 1898, and afterwards at the Brockton [Massachusetts] Public Library. Starting in 1899, he served as the Librarian of the Haverhill Public Library in Haverhill, Massachusetts, for 21 years. He was a member of the American Library Association and the Massachusetts Library Club for many years. He died on 8 July 1921, in Haverhill.

### Scope and Content Note

This collection mostly contains copies of talks given by John G. Moulton, Librarian of the Haverhill Public Library in Haverhill, Massachusetts. The collection has two series. Series one contains essays and papers that may or may not have been published. Series two contains one newspaper clipping about a lecture that he gave at the First Universalist Church in Haverhill, Massachusetts.
