Abstract:	This collection provides information about the history and development of the Haverhill [Massachusetts] Cycle Club.

Organizational History

The Haverhill Cycle Club was founded on 24 September 1895, for the purpose of "promoting athletic exercises by the use of bicycles... and for social purposes." It held races and meets and, in 1894, held a minstrel show at the Academy of Music. The club had rooms at the Daggett building and later at the Academy of Music. By 1916, the club was mostly a social one.

Scope and Content Note

This collection provides information about the history and development of the Haverhill [Massachusetts] Cycle Club. There is only one series. Series one contains ribbons that riders used and wore, two booklets of by-laws, a program from a minstrel show, a scrapbook of newspaper clippings that covers the years 1890-1907, and a folder of newspaper clippings that covers the years 1896-1926.
