<b>Abstract:</b>	The collection contains letters, record books, and photographs from the Fortnightly Club of Haverhill, Massachusetts, a men's club that held regularly scheduled meetings to discuss history, science, and current events.

### **Organizational History**

At a meeting of 15 men at the house of James R. Nichols on 11 March 1878, the Fortnightly Club of Haverhill, Massachusetts, was founded "for the purpose of scientific, literary, and social improvement." The first meeting was held at the home of George W. Duncan on March 25, 1878. The rules and regulations originally adopted were few and simple. The number of active members was limited to 25, which was later increased to 30. Annual dues were set at \$1.00 (later raised to \$2.00). Essays on various topics were assigned to members in advance and discussion followed the presentation. Refreshments usually followed the formal part of the evening. When the ladies (wives) were periodically invited, music was played.

The Fortnightly Club dissolved in 1999 due to internal differences. A majority of members resigned together and formed the Essex Club.

## Scope and Content Note

The collection contains letters, record books, and photographs from the Fortnightly Club of Haverhill, Massachusetts, a men's club that held regularly scheduled meetings to discuss history, science, and current events. Series one contains meeting invitations, treasurer's reports, correspondence, agendas, and attendance records for the club. Series two consists of two member books containing portraits of the club members, talks given by members, photographic portraits of some members, and a partial list of members from the inception of the club. Series three contains 14 record books of the club's meetings from its inception until 1993, two pages of notes about a 1982 meeting, and a partial transcription of the record books. Missing are records for 1935/1936 through 1946/1947, most of 1954/1955, and all of 1955/1956 and 1956/1957.
