<b>Abstract:</b>	The Winter Street Baptist Church of Haverhill records document the activities, memberships, financial transactions, pastoral activities, and social activities of the church in the 19 <sup>th</sup> and 20 <sup>th</sup> centuries.

### Organizational History

There were many Free Will Baptist followers in Haverhill and Bradford in 1858, but they had no church home of their own; they had to worship in the established Congregational or Baptist churches. On 22 April 1858, five men (Harold K. Snow, Samuel Garland, Levi Pearce, Horace K. Ford, and Mr. Wilson) met at the home of Harold Snow to discuss "trying to sustain Free Will Baptist preaching in Haverhill." The group decided to hold four trial preaching services on consecutive Sundays. They rented the Athenaeum Hall on Main Street.

The first services were held on 27 June 1858 by Rev. William C. Clark. Interest rapidly increased and it became necessary to find or build a hall suitable for the growing group. It was decided to build, and a lot of land was purchased on the east side of White Street, near Winter Street. A vestry, costing \$1,100 was immediately erected on the rear of the lot. The building was dedicated on 6 January 1859, when a church was organized. It consisted of 23 people called the Free Will Baptist Society. The society was incorporated on 25 June 1860 and the first meeting under the new charter was held on 9 July.

Soon after the organization of the church, a difficulty arose among its members. On 10 December 1859, some of the members, including the pastor, seceded and formed the Randall Church. In April 1860 the original society purchased the church building of the Winter Street

Congregational Society for \$11,000 and immediately moved to that location. Soon after Rev. Joseph S. Burgess of Lewiston, Maine, became their pastor. They were called the Winter Street Free Will Baptist Church (1860-1906). In 1906, the Society and church organizations were united into one body and incorporated as the Winter Street Free Baptist Church (1906 to 1937). From 1937 to 1950, they were the Winter Street Baptist Church, Inc. In 1950, they merged with the First Baptist Church in Haverhill.

## Scope and Content Note

The Winter Street Baptist Church of Haverhill records document the activities, memberships, financial transactions, pastoral activities, and social activities of the church in the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. The material has been organized into five series. Series one contains record books, by-laws, reports, correspondence, merger documents, lists of officers and committees, articles of faith, church covenant, lists of members, constituency lists, and an address. Series two contains financial records such as treasurers' reports, committee reports, financial reports, a record book, information on the sale of the church building, and a blank check. Series three contains papers of ministers including correspondence, newspaper clippings, and a photograph for 17 of the ministers who served in the church, as well as correspondence to members, and a Bible that was used in the pulpit. It also contains weekly bulletins and monthly newsletters sent to members, and programs. Series four contains an account book for the Ladies Mission Society. Series five contains news clippings, scrapbooks of news clippings, and a photographic postcard.
