Abstract:	This collection contains records, financial documents, programs, and newspaper clippings related to the Major How G.A.R. Post 47 of Haverhill, Massachusetts.

Organizational History

G.A.R. (Grand Army of the Republic) Post number 47 was founded in Haverhill, Massachusetts in 1868. It was named after Major Henry Jackson How, a native of Haverhill who was killed in combat on 30 June 1862 in Glendale, Virginia. The post had no space of its own prior to 1892 when it acquired and refitted Passquoi Hall on Court Street in Haverhill. An associated W.R.C. (Women's Relief Corps) was established in 1889. The organization participated in regular memorial activities for 71 years before the death of its last remaining member, Ezra G. Bly, on 18 March 1939.
