Abstract:	Julia Noyes Stickney was a speaker at women's suffrage events, and published poems and articles in newspapers from the 1880s to 1890s. This collection contains scrapbooks of her writings.

Biographical Sketch

Julia Noyes Stickney was born on July 5, 1830 in West Newbury, and graduated from Bradford Academy in 1850. She married Charles Stickney of Groveland and they had seven children together. In the 1880s, Julia began speaking at women's suffrage events, as well as publishing poems and articles in newspapers. She and Charles divorced in 1884; Charles moved to Wisconsin and Julia decided to focus on her writing. In addition to her poems, Julia also published three collections of poetry: *Poems of Lake Winnepesaukee* (1884), *One Hundred Sonnets* (1894), and *In the Valley of the Merrimack* (1891). She died on March 11, 1910.

This collection contains a series of scrapbooks containing newspaper clippings of articles, columns, and poems written by Julia Noyes Stickney.
