Biographical Sketch

Raymond Benjamin Clogston was born on June 25, 1882 to Harry and Mattie Clogston. He grew up and attended school in Haverhill (Mass.) and graduated from the Lowell (Mass.) Textile School in 1904. In 1909, he married Marion Langston and they had three children: Carleton Hill, R. Benjamin, and Samuel L. Clogston. He worked as a dyeing overseer for the Merrimack Manufacturing Company in Lowell, Massachusetts. He died in 1978.
