**Abstract:** This collection contains the personal papers of Haverhill (Mass.)

shoe manufacturer, Albert L. Kimball, and his immediate family, as

well as newspaper clippings of his extended family.

#### **Biographical Sketch**

Albert L. Kimball was born on September 15, 1837, to Albert and Elizabeth Kimball. In 1858, he joined his father's shoe manufacturing business and became a partner in 1860. He retired in 1887. He also served as the director of the First National Bank of Haverhill, was Justice of the Peace, and was a deacon and superintendent of the Sabbath School for the First Congregational Church. He married Isabella Louisa Ames on April 24, 1861. Isabella was born on July 2, 1841, and graduated from Bradford Academy in 1859. They had a daughter, Mara J., and two sons, George Edmund and Herbert Winslow. Albert L. Kimball died in 1889.

Edwin C. Kimball was born in 1850 to Albert and Elizabeth Kimball, the younger brother of Albert L. Kimball. In 1889, he founded Kimball's European Tours, which catered to small private parties traveling abroad. In addition to English, he spoke French, German, Italian, and Spanish. He died on February 3, 1944.

George Edmund Kimball was born on October 15, 1868, to Albert L. and Isabella Kimball. He married Daisy B. Littlefield on September 7, 1892. In 1896, he partnered with Joseph C. Kimball to manufacture shoes under the business J. C. and G. E. Kimball. The partnership ended in 1899, and George began working for the Essex National Bank. In 1903, he shifted his career to real estate and insurance. In 1917, he organized and incorporated the Automatic Fire Alarm Company and became the treasurer. He was also a deacon and treasurer for the First Church of Christ. As a hobby, he collected and restored antique furniture. George Edmund Kimball died on June 12, 1959.
