Abstract: This collection contains artwork and photography by Haverhill

(Mass.) artist, Sidney Marsh Chase.

Biographical Sketch

Sidney Marsh Chase was born in Haverhill on June 19, 1877, to Charles H. Chase and Mary (Carleton) Chase. He attended Harvard University and, upon graduation, he attended the Eric Pape School of Art in Boston, where he studied alongside N. C. Wyeth (1882-1945). He also studied art under Howard Pyle, and later became a recognized artist in both oils and watercolors. He provided illustrations and short stories for numerous magazines, including *Scribner's*, *Harper's Weekly*, *Saturday Evening Post*, and *Collier's*.

In 1925, Chase married Florence Mary Lowe, who taught at Haverhill High School for four years. Chase was a trustee of the Haverhill Public Library for 40 years. He died on June 12, 1957.
