<b>Abstract:</b>	The collection contains maps relating to Haverhill, Bradford, Essex County, the state of Massachusetts, and New England.

### Organizational History

The Haverhill Public Library was established in 1873 in an agreement between E.J.M. Hale and the City of Haverhill. Since then, the library has maintained a collection of materials relating to local history, genealogy, and native poet John Greenleaf Whittier. In 1916, the Pecker Collection, dedicated to New England, state, and town histories, was started and was later expanded in 1932 to include family histories and genealogical material. In 1923, the Haverhill Collection was formally established to preserve and collect local history materials for future generations. In 1969, with the construction of a new library building, plans called for two rooms to house the materials that made up the Whittier, Local History, and Genealogy collections and formalized the Special Collections Department. Historical materials include a comprehensive collection of maps from Haverhill, the surrounding regions, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and New England.

## Scope and Content Note

**Series 1** contains maps of the City of Haverhill, including Bradford, divided into 16 subseries by type, then arranged chronologically or alphabetically as indicated by the subseries description. Materials include street maps, zoning maps, cemetery maps, land plots, and blueprints. Earliest maps are modern reproductions and photocopies.

**Series 2** contains maps of the Merrimack Valley of Massachusetts and New Hampshire. Included in this series are outline maps, points of interest maps, railroad maps, and historical maps of cities and towns in the Merrimack River Valley, including Middlesex County and New Hampshire regions.

**Series 3** contains maps of Essex County. Included are outline maps of the county, highway maps, and historical maps of cities and towns. Essex County towns that are part of the Merrimack Valley are in Series 2.

**Series 4** contains maps of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Included are outline maps, points of interest, and maps of cities and towns outside Merrimack Valley and Essex County regions in Series 2 and 3. Earliest maps are modern reproductions.

**Series 5** contains maps of New England. Included are outline maps of New England, railroad maps, and road maps. State maps outside of Massachusetts are included in this series.

Series 2 through 5 are arranged according to the subseries of Series 1 or alphabetically by city, town, or property name, then chronologically. Oversized maps and rolled maps located in the Haverhill Room are listed at the end of each series or subseries.
