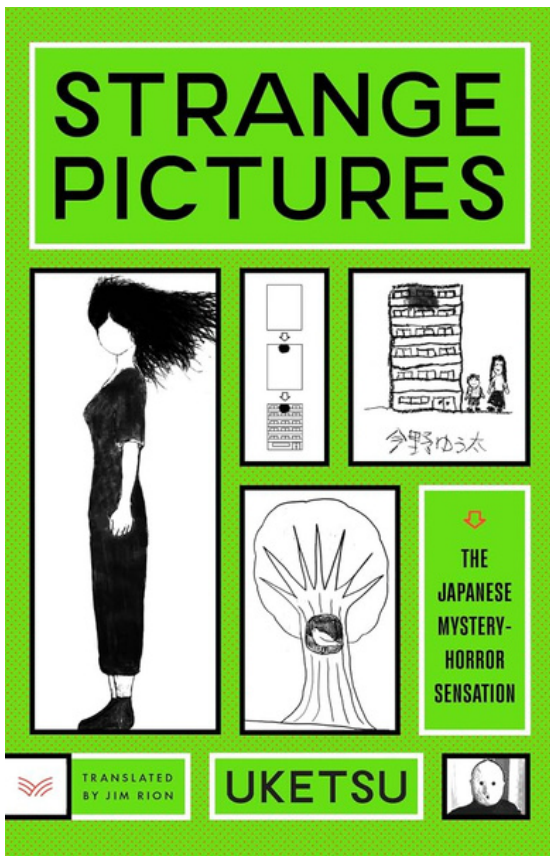




Strange Pictures
