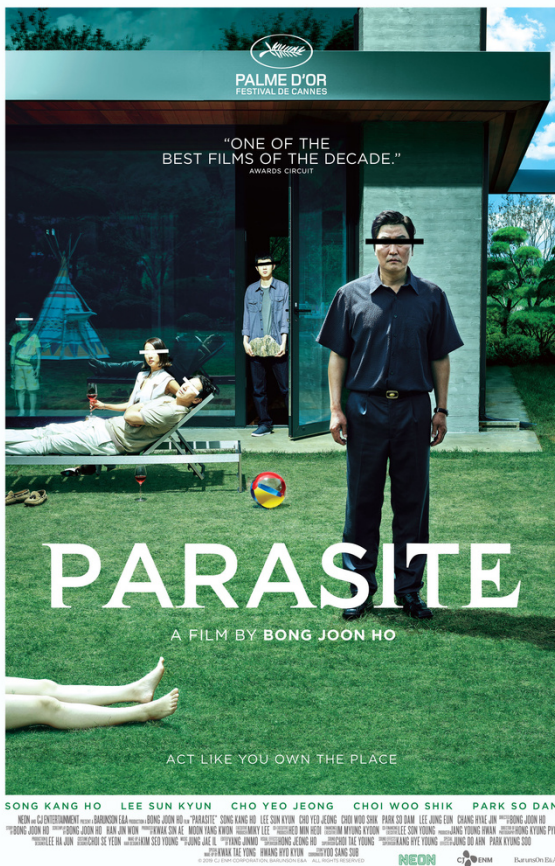




Parasite
